



## CHARLENE DRAKE SCHOLARSHIP

Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated, Xi Mu Zeta Chapter, is chartered in Markham, Illinois. In giving back to our organization, a scholarship was developed to provide financial assistance to an undergraduate member. This award is named in memory of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority sister Charlene Drake and given to an undergraduate sorority member, to promote that Zeta-spirited individual who strives to reach her highest goals in Zeta and her academic endeavors.

Miss Drake was born in Robbins, Illinois on August 8, 1952 and always had a commitment to the south suburban area. Her final employment was Comptroller for the city of Harvey, Illinois. Miss Drake embodied the many parallel characteristics that we strive to see in our undergraduate leaders of tomorrow; scholastically successful; actively participating in the sorority on the local, state, regional, and national levels; professional in all aspects; organized; and progressive.

On April 30, 1971, Miss Drake was initiated into the sisterhood through Eta Delta Chapter of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc., at Northern Illinois University. She was a pioneer in that she was a charter member of Eta Delta. Miss Drake progressively and swiftly moved forth in her Zeta life and her career. Always a part of ground breaking ideas and plans, she never tired in her work for the sorority and was an active sorority sister until her death in October of 1989, at which she lost her battle with breast cancer at the young age of 37.
